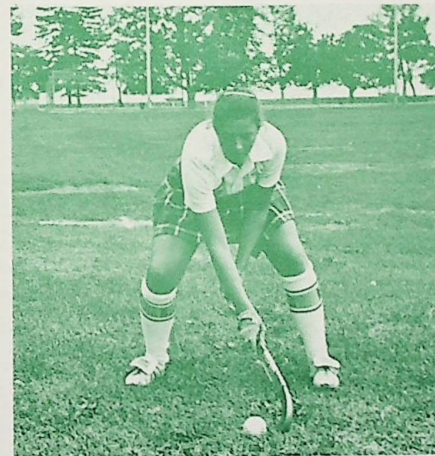

1980-1981 Highlights

Beginning with the annual pre-season camp in late August and a summer conditioning program, the University of Bridgeport vigorously confronted its first five opponents in victorious fashion. With the scoring thrust of U.S. Squad Member Donna Nielsen and adept leadership of Senior Captains Brenda Frey and Cheryl Silva, the Purple Knights established a seasonal record of 14-5-2. As in 1979, our squad continued to dominate our competitors at the Northeast All-College Tournament at the close of the season. Ten of our fourteen players were selected of approximately 200 women athletes to represent the All-College Sectional Division of the Northeast Sectional Tournament. We were undefeated once again in post-seasonal competition facing Skidmore College, Colby College, and Boston University. Coach Harrison, herself a former United States Squad Member, led the All-College II team to championship status at the Northeast Tournament. She also was selected to coach within the Olympic Development system during the summer of 1981. She looks forward to the challenge of a new season of AIAW competition.
