THE ACADEMIC REGALIA

In the 12th and 13th centuries, when Universities were taking form, they were under the jurisdiction of the Church. Most of those studying were Clerks in Holy Orders, or monks, and some were priests. They wore a habit, or cloak to which was attached a cowl or hood, which could be pulled up over the head, or thrown back, according to the weather. Gowns were probably very necessary for warmth in the unheated buildings, and hoods seem to have served to cover the tonsured head before the use of the skull cap.

Today the cap, gown and hood have taken on a symbolic meaning but with the colors and the shape conforming to an academic code which indicates the faculty conferring the degree and the kind of degree conferred.

Gowns for the Bachelor's degree have a semi-stiff yoke, long pleated front and intricate shirting across the shoulders and back. This gown is worn closed and is distinguished by its long, pointed sleeves.

Gowns for the Master's degree have the same yoke effect, but are designed to be worn open. They have a very long sleeve, oblong in shape with an arc cut out at the bottom of the front. The oblong is closed at the base and the forearm protrudes through a notched slit near the elbow.

Gowns for the Doctor's degree are also designed to be worn open, but carry velvet panels draped around the neck and stitched down the front edges. These panels are about 5 inches wide at the chest and continue all the way down to the bottom of the gown. Three horizontal velvet bars are stitched to the upper arm of the full, round, bell-shaped sleeves. This trimming may be either black or the distinctive color of the faculty conferring the degree.

In America, the hood is the most outstanding feature of the academic costume. Originally, it seems to have had three uses; as a head covering, as a shoulder cape, or as a bag in which to carry small items. These hoods are mentioned in literature as early as the 1480's. In the earliest days of the use of the hood, many were lined with fur. The size and shape of the hood marks the college degree of the wearer and the university conferring the degree.

The outside of the hood is made of black material. It is bordered with a slim strip of velvet to indicate the specific faculty awarding the degree. The colored lining of the inside of the hood is the official color of the institution conferring the degree. This may be a solid color, a chevron, a double or triple chevron. Holders of foreign degrees may wear hoods of the American style but lined with the national colors.
