LOWELL P. WEICKER, JR.
United States Senator

In a brief period of eight years, Lowell P. Weicker, Jr. went from the Connecticut General Assembly to the United States Senate, winning eight straight election contests on the way. His career in local, state and federal service is based on his deep belief that our democratic system can be and is responsive in anticipating and solving the nation's needs. That belief underlies his dedication in calling on young people to become involved in politics and government. He holds out his own career

as evidence that the voice and influence of young America can be effective. In 1962, at the age of 31, Weicker was elected a Representative from his hometown of Greenwich to the Connecticut General Assembly. He was re-elected to a third term in 1966. In 1963, while still in the Assembly, he was elected First Selectman of Greenwich, the New England equivalent of Mayor. He was re-elected to that position in 1965. Weicker was elected Congressman from the Fourth Congressional District in 1968, defeating the Democratic incumbent by 9,026 votes. In 1970, after one term in the House, Weicker won the United States Senate seat by defeating the late Thomas J. Dodd and the Reverend Joseph Duffey by an 86,000 plurality. In his first term in the House, he won on the floor an almost unprecedented victory for a freshman of the minority party. He authored an amendment requiring that housing demolished under urban renewal must be replaced on a unit-for-unit basis. When President Nixon signed the bill into law, one-for-one replacement of housing ended years of "urban removal". He has worked tirelessly to bring about for the nation a sound, balanced transportation program which recognizes the need for better intercity and mass transit service. He was born in Paris on May 16, 1931. He graduated from Lawrenceville School in 1949, won his B.A. in Political Science at Yale University in 1953, and his LL.B. at the University of Virginia in 1958.
